## Step 1:

- Access <u>www.novitas-solutions.com</u>. Select the appropriate JL/JH map and your Part A/Part B preference, if needed.
- · Expand the Electronic Billing-EDI menu on the left side bar.
- · Click the EDI Password Change option from the submenu.
- Enter your Login ID
- Enter the initial password, which is assigned as Hms#LLLL where LLLL represents the 4 characters of your login ID that precede the @ symbol (in upper case).
- Enter a new password.
- · Enter the new password a second time to confirm.
- Click submit. A message will indicate that your password has been successfully updated.

## • Step 2:

The endpoint for the new TIBCO Novitas gateway is accessible via a new name/IP: <a href="mailto:edi.novitas.ahdsxhub.com">edi.novitas.ahdsxhub.com</a> - 100.64.47.37

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For AWS-1 customers: The IP remains the same (100.64.49.21), but the port number has changed from 3322 to 3722.

## Step 3:

Update application configurations.

  - o /outbox/EZComm/BC/1.0/Notify for .ZIP files
- · Retrieve the ANSI X12N responses from:
  - o /inbox/X12/EDI/Outbound/Interchange for X12 files
  - /inbox/EZComm/BC/1.0/Notify for . ZIP files or VA reports
- Retrieve any ANSI X12N TA1 responses from
  - /inbox/X12/00501/EmptyGroup/TA1
